Some of the diseases controlled include brown patch, summer patch, septoria leaf spot, dollar spot, melting out, copper spot rusts, powdery mildew, red thread, scab, blossom blight, petal blight, anthracnose, needle rust, necrotic ring spot and cercospora leaf spot. Eagle WSP gives you consistent disease control, whatever the weather, even under the most demanding conditions.

Active Ingredient

Myclobutanil 40%

Packaging

Application Sites

Turf, ornamentals, commercial and residential landscape ornamentals, backyard / non-commercial tree fruits and vines.

Application Rates

Turf – 0.5 to 1.2 oz. / 1000 sq. ft. One Eagle WSP will treat 2500 – 6000 sq. ft.

Ornamentals – 3 oz. (one wsp) product per 50 to 100 gallons of water.

Fruit trees and vines – 1.0 to 3.0 oz. / 100 gallons of water, vines 3.0 to 5.0 oz. / acre.

- Tank mix compatible with most commonly used fungicides, insecticides, and spray adjuvants.
- Extremely low use rate gives more performance with less material while reducing the risk to the environment.
- Exceptional turfgrass safety to the major turf types.
- Stays in the top three inches of the soil until it's completely broken down, reducing the potential for runoff.
- Safe and easy-to-use water-soluble pouches. Just toss, agitate, and spray.
- Both a preventative and curative for optimum disease control.
